ADVERTISEMENT

In pursuance of the approval of the competent authority of the Karbi Anglong Autonomous Council, Diphu, vide No. KAAC/FIN-A-36/Prior/Approval/2024/16, dated 06/11/2024 and No. KAAC/Estt.-325/Prior approval of posts/AH&Vety/2021-22/17, dated 07/05/2025 and No. KDVD/Prior Approval/SIU/2/2023-24/199, dated 30/07/2025, applications in Standard Form are hereby invited from the eligible candidates who have successfully completed the prescribed training course of One Year V.F.A. Training Course in Elementary Knowledge of Animal Husbandry & Veterinary Science at the School of Veterinary Science & Animal Husbandry, Ghungoor, Silchar, for filling up the following 49 (Forty-nine) vacant posts of Veterinary Field Assistant (VFA) under the Animal Husbandry & Veterinary Department, Karbi Anglong Autonomous Council, subject to fulfilment of all prescribed conditions and availability of sanctioned vacancies.

The recruitment shall be governed by the provisions of the Assam Animal Husbandry & Veterinary Subordinate Service Rules, 2002, as amended from time to time, and other rules/orders applicable to the service.

1. Name and Number of Post

The number of posts indicated above shall be subject to availability of sanctioned vacant posts and approval of the competent authority.

2. Eligibility: - The candidates eligible to apply under this advertisement shall be those candidates who:

- were selected by the Central Selection Board, KAAC, for undergoing the One Year VFA Training Course pursuant to Advertisement No. KAAC/T&D-300/Pt.I/PC/CSB/2024-25/03, dated 20th December'2024 and Advertisement No. KAAC/T&D-300/Pt.I/PC/CSB/2024-25/10, dated 14th May'2025 and Prior Approval No. KDVD/Prior Approval/SIU/202324/199, dated 30/07/2025.
- have successfully completed the prescribed One Year Training Course in Elementary Knowledge of Animal Husbandry & Veterinary Science from the recognised School of Veterinary Science & Animal Husbandry, Ghungoor, Silchar;
- fulfil all other conditions prescribed under the Assam Animal Husbandry & Veterinary Subordinate Service Rules, 2002, as amended from time to time, and other applicable rules/orders.

3. Educational Qualification: - For direct recruitment to the cadre of Veterinary Field Assistant, a candidate shall have:

- passed the HSSLC (Science) Examination with Biology as a subject from a recognised Board/Council; and
- successfully completed the prescribed One Year Training Course in Elementary Knowledge of Animal Husbandry & Veterinary Science from the recognised School of Veterinary Science & Animal Husbandry, Ghungoor, Silchar.
- The qualification shall be as prescribed under the applicable provisions of the Assam Animal Husbandry & Veterinary Subordinate Service Rules, 2002, as amended from time to time.

4. Age: - The age of the candidates shall be governed by the applicable provisions of the Assam Animal Husbandry & Veterinary Subordinate Service Rules, 2002, and Government orders/instructions in force from time to time. The age of the candidate shall be determined on the basis of the HSLC Certificate / HSLC Admit Card or certificate issued by a recognised Board/Council. No other document shall ordinarily be accepted as proof of age.

5. Physical Fitness: - A candidate for direct recruitment to the cadre of Veterinary Field Assistant shall be of sound health, both mentally and physically, and free from any organic defect or bodily infirmity likely to interfere with the efficient performance of his/her duties. The selected candidates shall be required to undergo medical examination before appointment to the service.

6. Selection Procedure: - The selection of candidates shall be made by the Central Selection Board on the basis of merit, subject to fulfilment of all prescribed eligibility conditions, availability of sanctioned vacant posts and observance of the applicable reservation policy. Since the candidates covered under this advertisement have already been selected by the Central Selection Board for undergoing the prescribed One Year VFA Training Course and have successfully completed the said training, no fresh written examination shall be conducted.

The candidates shall be assessed on the following basis:

Method of Assessment –

- HSSLC (Science) Examination – 20 Marks:** Twenty percent (20%) of the percentage of marks obtained by the candidate in the HSSLC (Science) Examination shall be taken into consideration.
- One Year VFA Training Course – 40 Marks:** Forty percent (40%) of the percentage of marks obtained by the candidate in the prescribed One Year VFA Training Course in Elementary Knowledge of Animal Husbandry & Veterinary Science shall be taken into consideration.
- Viva-Voce – 40 Marks:** The eligible candidates shall appear before the Central Selection Board/Interview Board for Viva-Voce carrying 40 (forty) marks. The Viva-Voce may assess the candidate's knowledge of basic Animal Husbandry & Veterinary Science, practical understanding acquired during the training course, general awareness, suitability for the post and other matters considered relevant by the Selection Board.

The marks obtained under A, B and C above shall be added together to arrive at the candidate's total score out of 100 marks.

The candidates shall thereafter be placed in order of merit on the basis of the total marks obtained, subject to the applicable reservation policy and availability of vacancies.

In the event of a tie in the total marks, the candidate securing higher marks in the VFA Training Course shall be placed higher in the merit list. If the tie still persists, the candidate securing higher marks in the Viva-Voce shall be placed higher.

The final recommendation of the Central Selection Board shall be subject to verification of original certificates/testimonials, medical fitness, character and antecedent verification wherever applicable, and approval of the competent authority.

Note: Mere completion of the VFA Training Course shall not confer an absolute right to appointment. Appointment shall be made only against available sanctioned vacant posts and subject to fulfilment of all prescribed conditions.

7. Documents to be Produced: - The candidates shall produce the following original documents/certificates at the time of Interview / Viva-Voce / Document Verification or whenever called for by the Central Selection Board:

- HSLC Certificate/Admit Card as proof of age;
 - HSLC Marksheet;
 - HSLC (Science) Certificate and Marksheet showing Biology as a subject;
 - VFA Training Course Certificate/Certificate of successful completion of the One Year Training Course in Elementary Knowledge of Animal Husbandry & Veterinary Science;
 - Permanent Resident Certificate (PRC)/Domicile Certificate, as applicable;
 - Caste/Category Certificate, wherever applicable;
 - Certificate of physical/medical fitness, wherever required;
 - Declaration in Form-'A' under the Assam Public Services (Application of Small Family Norms in Direct Recruitment) Rules, 2019, wherever applicable;
 - Recent passport-size photographs; and
 - Any other certificate/document as may be required by the Central Selection Board.
- Candidates shall produce the original certificates and testimonials for verification. Failure to produce the required original documents may result in cancellation of candidature.

8. How to Apply -

- The intending eligible candidates shall submit their applications in Standard Form as published in Part-IX of the Assam Gazette, duly filled in and accompanied by the required testimonials/documents.

- The duly filled-in application shall be submitted by hand in the Drop Box at the office of the Central Selection Board, KAAC, Diphu, during office hours, or may be sent by Registered Post / Speed Post, so as to reach the office from 20th August 2026 to 7th September 2026 (on or before 5:00 PM).
- The envelope containing the application should be clearly superscribed: **"APPLICATION FOR THE POST OF VETERINARY FIELD ASSISTANT (VFA)"**
- The applicant shall affix one recent passport-size photograph on the application form and enclose another recent passport-size photograph along with the application.
- The applicant shall enclose a KAAC Money Receipt of ₹10/- (Rupees Ten) only for ST/SC candidates and ₹20/- (Rupees Twenty) only for candidates belonging to other categories, towards application fee.
- The candidate shall also enclose a self-addressed stamped envelope of size 23 cm x 11 cm bearing postal stamp of ₹5/- for communication.
- No Bank Draft/Money Order/Cash/Cheque shall be accepted towards payment of the application fee.
- The candidates shall furnish self-attested copies of all certificates, mark sheets and other testimonials declared by them to be true copies of the originals.

9. Last Date for Submission of Application -

- The duly filled-in applications must reach the office of the Central Selection Board, KAAC, Diphu, from 20th August 2026 to 7th September 2026 (on or before 5:00 PM).
- No application shall be entertained or received after the last date and time.
- The Central Selection Board shall not be responsible for any postal delay, loss or non-receipt of applications/documents sent through post.

10. Reservation: - Reservation of posts shall be applicable in accordance with the reservation policy, rules and Government instructions applicable to the Karbi Anglong Autonomous Council. The benefit of reservation shall be available only to candidates who furnish valid certificates issued by the competent authority.

11. General Conditions

- The candidates must satisfy all the eligibility conditions prescribed under the applicable rules.
- Incomplete, defective or improperly filled applications shall be liable to rejection.
- The Central Selection Board reserves the right to reject any application/candidature at any stage if the candidate is found ineligible or if any information/document furnished by the candidate is found to be false, incorrect or misleading.
- If any false declaration or statement is detected at any stage, the candidature shall be liable to rejection, and appropriate action may be taken under the applicable Rules/Law.
- Candidates must produce all original certificates and testimonials whenever called for by the Central Selection Board.
- No TA/DA shall be admissible for appearing in the Interview/Viva-Voce/Document Verification.
- Canvassing directly or indirectly in any form shall disqualify the candidate.
- The selected candidates shall be liable to serve in any place under the jurisdiction of the Karbi Anglong Autonomous Council as may be decided by the competent authority in the interest of public service.
- The selected candidates shall be required to abide by the terms and conditions of service prescribed by the competent authority and applicable rules/orders from time to time.
- Appointment shall be subject to satisfactory medical fitness and verification of character and antecedents, wherever applicable.
- The inclusion of a candidate's name in the select/recommendation list shall not confer any right to appointment unless the appointing authority is satisfied, after such enquiry as may be considered necessary, that the candidate is suitable in all respects for appointment.
- The select/recommendation list shall remain valid for the period prescribed under the applicable rules.
- The selected candidates shall be required to join their respective places of posting within the period specified in the appointment order, failing which the appointment shall be liable to cancellation unless otherwise permitted by the competent authority.
- The Central Selection Board reserves the right to modify, correct, postpone, withdraw or cancel the advertisement/recruitment process, wholly or partly, if circumstances so warrant.
- All matters not specifically mentioned herein shall be governed by the Assam Animal Husbandry & Veterinary Subordinate Service Rules, 2002, as amended from time to time, and other rules/orders applicable to the service.
